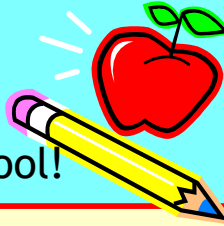

## A back to school transition guide.....

### Drop-Off Procedures

We are so glad to greet your child each morning for their school day. In order to help make your child's transition from home to school go as smoothly as possible we ask that you adhere to the following guidelines:

- ✓ Help your child be on time to school. Our school day starts at 7:35 am. (For the safety of your child, be sure that you drop your child off after 7:00am.)



- ✓ Allow your children to walk to the cafeteria or their classroom independently. You may bring them into the lobby and say your good-byes briefly at the stop sign if you wish, so that your child may begin their school day.
- ✓ Remember to enter the office first any time you visit the campus. We will be happy to assist you.

Thank you for helping us provide the safest environment possible for your precious children.

### Pick-up Procedures

Your help can make afternoon parent pick-up much smoother! Following these guidelines will make ending your child's school day safe and efficient:

- ✓ Parent pick-up begins at 3:10. Pre-K pickup will be at the circle drive, and Kindergarten will be at the front entrance. Please let your child reap the benefits of completing their school day.
- ✓ We will be transitioning from 2:50-3:10 and ask that you wait to pick your child up from school during this time.
- ✓ Keep children safe by remaining in your vehicle and waiting your turn in line. If you do have to get out of your vehicle to pick up your child you MUST sign them out in the office.
- ✓ Display your child's name in the windshield of your car. (You will be provided with a windshield name tag.)

Together we can ensure that your child's transition to and from school leaves them happy and secure.
